OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The Office of the Attorney General of Guam is actively seeking qualified individuals to serve as assistant attorneys general and carry out its mandates and the interests of the people and Territory of Guam.

The Office of the Attorney General provides legal representation, interpretation and guidance as the Chief Legal Officer of the government of Guam in criminal and civil matters and on the laws of Guam and the United States applicable to Guam. It consists of the Prosecution, Family, Civil Litigation-Solicitors, and Child Support Enforcement Divisions.

The Civil Litigation/Solicitors Division provides legal representation to the various boards and agencies of the government of Guam on a variety of issues including Constitutional law, government tort claims, and environmental law. It also provides the services of administrative hearing officers for those boards and commissions that conduct such hearings as well as represents the agencies before the Civil Service Commission.

The Family Division oversees matters before the Family Division of the Superior Court. This Division represents the Child Protective Services section of the Department of Public Health and Social Services and participates primarily in the adjudicatory processes of the Family Division of the Superior Court of Guam pertaining to juvenile, juvenile delinquency, and persons in need of services ("PINS") matters.

The Child Support Enforcement Division provides public service in locating non-custodial parents, establishing paternity, securing, modifying, and enforcing child and medical support orders, recovering TANF/Welfare benefits paid on behalf of the children, and processing child support payments.

Finally, the Prosecution Division is responsible for the adult criminal prosecution and enforcement of the criminal laws of Guam as referred to the Division from law enforcement authorities and those criminal offenses independently investigated by it which frequently include white collar, government corruption or public integrity crimes (e.g., misapplication of funds held in trust, embezzlement, official misconduct, etc.), and litigating all criminal appellate cases.
